PAYING ONLINE FOR SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

The Parent Online Payment (POP) system is the Department's preferred method of payment for school related activities. Have you tried paying for school activities online yet?

Go to the school website: www.uki-p.schools.nsw.gov.au

and click on the Make a Payment tab. You can pay for multiple items and students in the one transaction, just fill in the sections

marked with an *asterisk and put a description of what you are paying for in each line. You will receive a receipt for your transaction immediately and the school receives the funds the next business day.

Please return all notes with the date you have paid and the receipt number on them.

This payment system is for all **school collections only**; the P&C Uniforms and Instrumental programs are not to be paid for using POP as the P&C have their own bank accounts.

If you would like to make payments towards **school camps, swimming scheme, Spotlight Tickets, rehearsal buses** etc then try it out. Just ring the office if you are having any trouble and we can talk you through it, or come in with your card details and use our computer on the front desk.
