


FINAL ASSEMBLIES FOR 2024

OFFICE NEWS BOOK PACKS FOR 2025

In 2025 we will have book packs available for students. Each pack is capped at a cost of \$50 and you will be invoiced via SchoolBytes at the beginning of Term 1. We have compared retail prices for the items supplied and factoring in our bulk buying ability and the GST that the school can absorb you will save at minimum \$20 per package.

Payment will be due prior to your child receiving the books in the classroom. The book pack samples pictured here are the minimum supplies used in the classroom throughout the whole year, and if there are more items required the school will supply them (for example more textas if they run out).





